6. Overview of Recruitment and Training Initiatives

Leanne Heppell, Chief Ambulance Officer, and Brian Twaites, Public Relations Liaison Officer, provided an update on the initiatives currently underway, including advertising and public awareness programming currently underway to enhance the reach of BCEHS to attract staff to join the organization.



Mr. Twaites summarized the national recruitment program that is now underway, including radio, television, transit, as well as innovative partnerships with organizations such St. John's Ambulance, Scouts Canada and schools to highlight options for careers in emergency health services.

It is of note that the Ministry of Education is now offering high school credit for training in grade 11 for EMR certification. This training will be available in a wide range of communities making it an attractive option for rural and remote communities.
