6. Presentation: Prehospital Thrombolysis to Treat Heart Attack Earlier 6.46

Dr. Ganstal presented an overview of the BCEHS pre-hospital clot dissolving program and how the Advanced Care and Critical Care paramedics are involved in treating a STEMI (ST elevation myocardial infarction) so as to make the most effective treatment option of administering clot busting drug (thrombolysis) available in communities outside the major cardiac centres in the optimal treatment window available. The program is being expanded to include Penticton, Salmon Arm and Cranbrook, and on December 01 addressing the interior, followed by Island Health, Coastal and Northern Health which are two sites that have access to Advanced Care Paramedics and Critical Care Paramedics.
