BCEHS is consistently monitoring the potential overdose/poisoning call numbers. This is a snapshot of current data for paramedic-attended overdose call volumes across the province.

Overdose calls in BC

2020 27,067 (up 12% over last year)
2019 24,166
2018 23,662
2017 23,441
2016 19,275
2015 12,263

- 2004 2015: Overdose calls in B.C. fluctuated from 10,000 to 15,000 a year.
- 2016: BCEHS saw a dramatic increase in overdose call volumes (19,275).
- **2017**: Paramedics called to 23,441 overdose calls, representing a 21.6% increase from 2016.
- **2018**: Overdose call volumes plateaued, and the year ended with 221 more calls than in 2017 (23,662)
- **2019**: Overdose calls remained steady (up 2%) (24,166)
- **2020**: Overdose calls spiked during the pandemic with the highest number of overdose calls to date (27,067) up 12%.

Overdose Calls by Health Authority Region

The Vancouver Coastal and Fraser Health regions have the highest number of overdose calls; these regions serve more than 50% of BC's population.

Vancouver Coastal was the only region to have a *decrease* in overdose calls in 2020. The Northern Health region had significantly higher overdose call volumes, up 56%.

Overdose Calls Per Day

BCEHS paramedics responded to an average of **74** overdose/poisoning calls per day in B.C. during 2020.

Highest Overdose Month

In July 2020, paramedics in B.C. responded to the highest number of overdose calls ever recorded in a month, since the opioid crisis was officially declared in 2016.

Paramedics were called to 2,706 overdose calls in July; 87 overdose calls a day.

o The average monthly call volume had been about 2,000 calls a month.

Top Five Communities for Overdose Calls

BCEHS dispatch receives the most calls for overdoses from our largest metro centres: Vancouver, Surrey and Victoria.

Vancouver averages about **22** overdose calls a day to BCEHS paramedics
